

The first printed copy of the Star was created in June 1944. In Nov/Dec 1944 the handful of patients worked very hard learning all the ins and outs of the newspaper business. With their all their heart, soul and determination a thirty-two-page issue with many pictures depicting Carville old and new was produced and handed out. Conditions in Carville were getting better with each new publication. Hope was growing for the very first time.
